Remember due to Labor Day weekend our practice time changes.

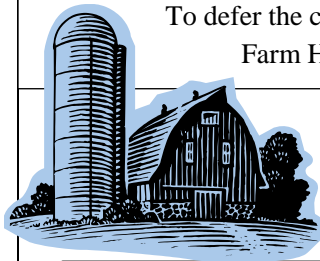
